



2019 Ramsay Art Prize Conditions

1. Submissions to the 2019 Ramsay Art Prize must be uploaded to the artgallery.sa.gov.au/ramsay website between the hours of 10.00am, 14 September and 5.00pm, 14 December 2018 (ACST -Australian Central Standard Time).
2. The entrant must be under the age of 40 on 14 December 2018 (submission deadline). Proof of age may be required.
3. Entrants must be Australian citizens or permanent residents and must be living in Australia as their main place of residence.
4. Entry is limited to one work per person or collective.
5. The entrant must be the owner of the work submitted for judging and the work must be available for acquisition to meet the requirement of the acquisitive prize. Where the work has been created by more than one person, the entrant must be authorised in writing by all creators of the work, to submit the work in accordance with these conditions.
6. The work of art must be original and must not infringe the copyright, moral rights, or other rights of any third party.
7. Works of art submitted for entry into the Ramsay Art Prize are not restricted by scale, medium or subject matter and can take any form, including (without limitation) sculpture, painting, drawing, photography, installation, sound digital, net or live art etc.
8. The term "Supporting Media Files" in the Entry Form refers to the supporting images, video or sound files documenting the work submitted.
9. The submitted work must be new work, that is, works must be completed after 14 December 2017.
10. Entry into the Ramsay Art Prize will incur a \$50 administration fee, including GST, payable by credit card at online entry portal at the time of entry.
11. Credit card payments will be accepted from Mastercard or Visa and will not incur an additional processing fee.
12. Entry into the 2019 Ramsay Art Prize requires completion of all components within the online entry form, including but not limited to:
 - a) Respond to the following three questions in the third person (maximum 100 words per question): 1) Describe yourself as an artist? 2) Describe the materials and processes used in the work? 3) Describe the ideas/ themes you are exploring?
 - b) Supporting media displaying the work (maximum of three, including a minimum of one still image)
 - c) Acceptance of all declarations
 - d) Payment of the entry fee
13. Only works selected as finalists for the prize need to be transported to the Art Gallery of South Australia (the "Gallery").
14. The entrant agrees to any embargo applicable to the Ramsay Art Prize finalist exhibition and/or winner announcement. The winning entrant must not disclose his/her/their identity during the embargo period.
15. The submitted work must be available for loan and display at the Gallery between February - October 2019.
16. The entrant grants to the Gallery (and its partners and sponsors) a perpetual, fee-free, non-exclusive licence to reproduce the submitted work in material form, to photograph, publish and/or communicate it to the public, for the following prize-related purposes:
 - a) marketing, publicity, educational, archival and publication uses for the Gallery, the prize and its exhibition in all media, including but not limited to electronic/digital, broadcasting and print media; and
 - b) anything incidental to such purposes.

Conditions continued

17. Where reasonable, the Gallery will attribute the artist as the author of the work and reproduce the work in full. Details of the work may be used at the Gallery's discretion.
18. Entrants acknowledge that all information provided as part of the entry to the 2019 Ramsay Art Prize may be used by the Gallery for purposes including, but not limited to, education, publicity and promotion.
19. If the submitted work is selected as a finalist for inclusion in the 2019 Ramsay Art Prize exhibition, the entrant will
 - a) make the selected work available for transportation to the Gallery for display in the finalist exhibition. The Gallery will be responsible for freight and installation, logistics and costs.
 - b) make themselves and the work available for marketing and media opportunities in relation to the promotion of the 2019 Ramsay Art Prize and its finalist exhibition, at the invitation of the Gallery.
20. The Gallery will be responsible for ensuring the work is insured nail to nail for the work value nominated and for the agreed loan period.
21. If awarded the 2019 Ramsay Art Prize, the entrant agrees that full ownership of the submitted work (but not copyright) will be transferred to the Gallery at no additional cost. The entrant agrees to sign any ownership transfer document provided by the Gallery. The entrant will retain all copyright in the work.
22. If awarded the 2019 Ramsay Art Prize, the entrant agrees to seek independent legal advice regarding acceptance of the Prize, including all tax implications.
23. If awarded the 2019 Ramsay Art Prize, the entrant agrees to provide two reports (no more than one page each) at six months and one year immediately following the award of the prize.
24. Selection of the winning work will be judged by an international panel. Panel judgement is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
25. At the conclusion of the 2019 Ramsay Art Prize finalist exhibition, works (other than the winner) will be returned to the entrant at no cost to the entrant.
26. The Gallery reserves the right to consider (at the Gallery's sole discretion) any entry, including without limitation a late entry or an entry by an entrant who has failed to comply with any of these conditions.

The Prize

1. Two monetary prizes are applicable to the Ramsay Art Prize including:
 - c) The Ramsay Art Prize, \$100,000 and acquisition into the Art Gallery of South Australia's collection
 - d) The People's Choice Prize, \$15,000
2. The Art Gallery of South Australia will pay the 2019 Ramsay Art Prize winner \$100,000 (no GST) following the announcement of the winner.
3. The Art Gallery of South Australia will pay the amount of \$15,000 (no GST) to the entrant who receives the highest number of audience votes for the People's Choice Prize following the announcement of the People's Choice Prize winner.
